DIRECTIONS:

Always pretest in an inconspicuous area for color fastness. Use in well ventilated areas and apply using a low drift sprayer tip if possible. INJECTION SPRAYER: Assuming an 8:1 ration, use 32 oz. per gallon of water for normal soiling and up to 48 oz. per gallon for heavy soiling. BONNET CLEANING/ELECTRIC OR PUMP SPRAYERS: mix 4 to 6 oz. per gallon of water for normal soiling and up to 12 oz. per gallon for heavy soil and organic stains. A dwell time of 5 to 10 minutes will be beneficial on organic stains and heavier soil. If organic staining persists, pre-spot and repeat. LAUNDRY: use 2 to 6 oz. per load. SPOTTING: mix 1:1 with water for maximum strength
